Legislative Committee Hearings on Proposed Bills Instructions to sign-up to participate

Committees are used as the initial step in reviewing/approving/rejecting proposed Bills. You can attend these sessions and participate in person or remotely via a Zoom call. You don't have to preregister for in-person participation (this is done at the entrance to the committee room). You must pre-register if you want to participate remotely via a Zoom type call.

To get information on when a committee meeting will be conducted on a specific Bill visit the State of Colorado General Assembly web site. Look up the Bill by number or topic in the Search box. Next, click on the Bill narrative that is displayed as a result of your search and it will take you to a page where you can access a copy of the Bill and at the bottom of the page when a committee hearing will be held. Normally, the hearings are conducted in downtown Denver at the State House. Note, the on-site location most likely will be shared to complete Committee hearings on other Bills. Although the hearings may begin at, for example, 1:30 pm, if multiple Bills are being considered note the list of Bills for the day. If your Bill is down the list your hearing may not be conducted until an hour or much more after 1:30 pm. Thus the alternative to providing your input on a Bill might best be completed via a remote testimony using an application such as Zoom.

Below are instructions to sign-up for remote participation. You will need to know the Bill number and description, date and time of hearing and the Committee conducting the meeting all which is displayed/revealed through the above instructions.

Click on Remotely via Zoom at bottom of page
Next, click on By Committee and Hearing Item
Next, bottom of page, select in the Committee Name drop-down list select
Next, under Meeting Date and Time select from drop down list
Next, under Hearing Item select the Bill ID
Next, enter personal identifying information and submit request
You will receive an email with instructions to log-into the meeting.

If there are two Bills on the same date and time you must sign up for each Bill separately.

If you plan on testifying (providing your comments verbally) to the Committee it is best to write your comments out and read them as you are only provided two minutes to do so.
